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## CMF Action Plan October Update

We continue to make progress on our commitment to be a good neighbor to the communities near the CMF. All but two of the short-term initiatives in the CMF Action Plan have been completed.

We have completed the installation and assessment of the sound monitors in our yard and completed the analysis of how we use ground power. We successfully expedited eight Tier 4 locomotives into service. Additionally, we added accountability metrics to our maintenance contract as part of the new bundled contract.

We will continue to make progress and provide monthly updates.

## Festival of Lights

Metrolink will run special train service to Festival of Lights at Riverside's Mission Inn Hotel and Spa from train stops throughout Los Angeles, Orange and Riverside counties! This special train service will run from November 29, 2019 until December 21, 2019. Entry to the festival is free of charge and taking the train is comfortable, convenient and stress-free. A round-trip Festival of Lights train ticket is only \$7.

USA Today has called the Festival of Lights "The Best Public Lights Display in the Nation," featuring approximately 4.5 million lights and a dazzling fireworks display. Additionally, the Festival of Lights includes more than 400 animated figures including angels, elves and Dickens carolers, appearances by Santa Claus, the world's largest man-made mistletoe, horse-drawn carriage rides, elaborately decorated Christmas trees in the lobby, and throughout the hotel and delectable holiday confections.

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## Tier 4 Update

As of November 29 , 2019 there are 30 Tier 4 locomotives delivered to SCRRRA property. Of these, 19 locomotives have been conditionally accepted.

- 24 locomotives are in service
- 6 are being prepared for service
- 20 Legacy Tier 0 locomotives have been decommissioned

Tier 4 locomotives reduce emissions between 65% and 85% compared to legacy Tier 2 and Tier 0 locomotives in Metrolink's fleet.
